DIVISION ENHANCEMENT TRAINING IN PREPARATION FOR THE REGIONAL
SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE 2025

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

1. In reference to **Regional Memorandum CLMD-2025-003**, the **2025 Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC)** will be conducted in **Sultan Kudarat on February 25-28, 2025**. All **RSPC 2025 Qualifiers**, as stipulated in **Division Memorandum CID-2025-040**, are enjoined to prepare and participate in the following enhancement training mechanisms:
