PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION REVIEW FOR SCHOOLS IMPLEMENTING
INDIGENOUS PEOPLES EDUCATION PROGRAM

1. The Curriculum Implementation Division – Instructional Management Section (CID-IMS) will conduct a **Program Implementation Review for Schools Implementing Indigenous Peoples Education (IPED) Program** from March 21 to 22, 2025 at Venue 88 Hotel and Events Place, General Santos City.

2. The activity aims to:

- a. monitor and evaluate IPED implementation towards enhancing the management and delivery of the basic education curriculum of schools serving IP learners;
- b. discuss issues and concerns affecting the schools implementing IPED Program;
- c. share the best practices/success stories on IPED Program implementation; and
- d. agree on the ways forward for the IPED Program Implementation.

- c. Reading Performance of Learners: (enrolment per grade level, Male/Female), number of non-decoders and frustration readers from grades 1 to 6, and the factors affecting their performance.
- d. IPED activities in the SIP and AIP (title of activity, physical target, financial target, and remarks, if conducted, ongoing, not yet conducted)
- e. School accomplishment, best practices, innovations including the awards received in DFOT, DSPC, SPAA, and other contests, please specify.
- f. Profile of consultative and advisory Body: (complete name and position in the community)
- g. CHLC establishment updates
- h. Emerging program implementation issues, proposed solutions, and needed management action from SDO



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5. Services rendered on a weekend shall be granted with appropriate service credits and compensatory time off, whichever is applicable.
6. Meals and accommodation will be borne from the 2024 IPED Program Support Fund while the travel and other incidental expenses of participants shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
