ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS) ADVOCACY AND COMMUNITY
LITERACY MAPPING FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2025-2026

To: Public Schools District Supervisors Concerned
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads Concerned

1. In cognizance to the promotion of the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels and to take appropriate steps to make education accessible to all, the Curriculum Implementation Division shall conduct an **Alternative Learning System (ALS) Advocacy and Community Literacy Mapping (CLM) from May 17 to June 14, 2025**. This division initiative shall engage the participation of the barangay officials to assist in the mapping.

2. The purpose of the activity is:

- a. to guarantee equitable access to all learners, including those who reside in the unreached and underserved communities to avail systematic, flexible, and appropriate alternative basic education outside of the formal school system;
- b. to promote lifelong learning opportunities and elevate socio-economic status, raise the level of literacy and contribute to an individual's sustainable future; and
- c. to determine the number of Out-of-School Youths (OSYs) and Out-of-School Youths and Adults (OSYAs) who need basic education and literacy.

3. The participants are the Education Program Specialist II, School Heads and ALS Teachers. Moreover, it is expected that coordination with the local barangay officials is sought prior to the conduct of the Community Literacy Mapping. Attached herewith are the list of participants, terms of references including the schedule of activities and list of templates to be utilized for the mapping.

4. All teaching and non-teaching participants in this activity are entitled to receive a maximum of 15 days service credits or CTO whichever is applicable for the services rendered in accordance with DepEd Order No. 13 s. 2024.



5. Travel expenses incurred relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged against local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
