We would like to express our sincere appreciation for the opportunity to present our **Bridging Reading Development Gaps in Early (BRIDGE) Education Program** to the division. We greatly value our longstanding partnership with DepEd Sarangani Division and share a collective mission to promote quality education, particularly in enhancing the reading skills of learners in our partner schools.

In light of this commitment and in response to recent reports indicating a concerning decline in reading proficiency and a growing number of functionally illiterate learners, we are pleased to inform your good office that Alcantara Foundation will implement a 15-day remedial reading intervention dubbed **School-Based Bayanihan (SBB)** in ten (10) public elementary schools in Sarangani Division:

- 1. Datal Basak IP Integrated School
- 2. Ludin Logan Elementary School
- 3. Langaran Elementary School
- Lebe integrated School
- 5. Nomoh Integrated School
- 6. Cabansal Larry IP Elementary School
- 7. Lun Padidu Central Elementary School

- 9. Alabel Central Integrated SPED Center
- 10. Datu Abdullah Tondog Elementary School

The SBB Program is a community-driven summer reading initiative designed to address early-grade reading gaps. It will engage both school personnel and community volunteers to provide targeted support to struggling readers. This cycle will specifically focus on 30 incoming Grade 4 learners per school, with an emphasis on developing essential English literacy skills such as letter-sound recognition,

decoding, blending, word recognition, and reading comprehension as aligned with the DepEd's Literacy Remediation Program (LRP).

To ensure effective delivery of the program and to align efforts with DepED's LRP, the Foundation will conduct a two-day Volunteers' Capacity Building Training on May 10-11, 2025 at London Beach Resort, Tambler, General Santos City., to be participated by 19 teachers and 61 youth/community volunteers. 
