Pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 1083, otherwise known as the Code of Muslim Personal Laws of the Philippines and Civil Service Commission Resolution No. 81-1277, **June 26, 2025 (Thursday) is recognized as a Muslim Holiday in observance of Amun Jadid (Islamic New Year).**

To give ample time to all employees to celebrate, the Province of Sarangani will be observing the above-mentioned as a non-working holiday.

However, in the interest and exigency of public service, all employees (except those of Islamic faith) scheduled to report for duty on the above-mentioned date and are assigned in the provincial jail, security, hospitals, and rescue service (PDRMO) shall continue to report for work and perform their respective function/s.
