**REITERATION ON THE UPLOADING OF THE WASH IN SCHOOLS (WinS) DATA
FOR SY 2024-2025 THROUGH THE ENHANCED ONLINE MONITORING
SYSTEM (e-OMS) IN LEARNER INFORMATION SYSTEM (LIS) PLATFORM**

To: Public Schools District Supervisors Concerned
Public Elementary and Secondary School Principals Concerned
Public Elementary and Secondary District Nurses Concerned
Public Elementary and Secondary WINS Coordinator Concerned

1. In reference to Regional Memorandum, All Public Elementary and Secondary Schools must upload their **WASH IN SCHOOLS (WinS) Data** using the Enhanced Online Monitoring Systems (e-OMS) through the Learner Information System (LIS) platform. The official uploading period is scheduled from **June 30, 2025 to August 29, 2025**.
2. All **designated School WinS Coordinators** are responsible for encoding and uploading the data. They must ensure the use of the new e-OMS Monitoring template, which reflects updated indicators and includes two (2) additional questions related to the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP). These new questions are integrated in partnership with GIZ to gather reliable and primary data that will support SBFP planning and implementation.
3. All School Heads are expected to supervise and assist their WinS Coordinators in ensuring the accurate and timely uploading of data, and to confirm that the most recent version of the e-OMS template is utilized.

SUBJECT : **UPLOADING OF THE WASH IN SCHOOLS (WinS) DATA FOR SY 2024-2025 THROUGH THE ENHANCED ONLINE MONITORING SYSTEM (e-OMS)**

DATE : **June 3, 2025**

The Department of Education (DepEd) Order No. 10, s. 2016, also known as the Policy and Guidelines for the Comprehensive Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) in Schools (WinS) Program, establishes quality standards for water, sanitation, hygiene, deworming, and health education. It aims to promote proper hygiene and sanitation practices among schoolchildren and ensure a clean, safe, and healthy school environment.

The WinS Program uses the Three-Star Approach (TSA), an integrated system for monitoring, quality assurance, and performance recognition. Outlined in DepEd Memorandum No. 19, s. 2018, it promotes continuous improvement and measurable results in school communities.

After years of implementing the WinS policy, DepEd and its partners recognized the need to integrate the WinS Online Monitoring System (OMS) into the Basic Education Information System (BEIS). To support this, BLSS-SHD, in collaboration with GIZ, UNICEF, and Save the Children Philippines, is amending DepEd Memorandum No. 194, s. 2018, to strengthen WinS monitoring and implementation, ensuring alignment with educational priorities and technological advancements.



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The results of the uploading for SY 2023-2024, which took place from June 15 to September 15, 2024, recorded a total participation rate of 96.95%, with 48,653 out of 50,183 schools nationwide. This marks a slight increase from the SY 2022-2023 results. This achievement reflects the combined efforts and dedication of our field implementers, who have diligently overseen the program's implementation.

In this regard, this Office officially announces the **National Uploading and Validation of the WASH in Schools (WinS) Program for SY 2024-2025** which will officially start on **June 30** and continue through **August 29, 2025**.

Furthermore, in relation to the said activity, the following are being advised:

1. All public elementary and secondary schools converted into integrated schools that are experiencing difficulties in uploading WinS data shall coordinate with their Schools Division Office (SDO) WinS coordinators. These schools shall submit their raw Excel files to the SDO WinS coordinators, who will then upload the data to the e-OMS.
2. In the case of system maintenance, the Regional Office WinS coordinators shall be informed.
3. Any other issues or concerns that arise should be addressed through the submission of a **support ticket**, which shall undergo a formal escalation process through the User Support Division (USD) and Solutions Development Division (SDD) of the Information and Communications Technology Service (ICTS).
4. To ensure proper guidance, all RO and SDO WinS coordinators are highly encouraged to revisit **DO 10, s. 2016** and **DM 194, s. 2018**.
