**DIVISION MEMORANDUM**

ARAL SCHOOL READINESS AND RESPONSIVENESS AUDIT (ASRRA)  
FOR THE ARAL PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent  
Chief Education Program Supervisors  
Public Schools District Supervisors  
Schoolheads

1. In reference to DepEd Order No. 018, s. 2025, or the *Implementing Guidelines on the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program*, and to ensure sustained quality and responsiveness in the program's implementation, all participating schools are hereby directed to **conduct the ARAL School Readiness and Responsiveness Audit (ASRRA)**.
2. The ASRRA is a structured and data-driven mechanism designed to assess school-level capacity and support systems across five key domains:
  - a. Learner Readiness
  - b. Teacher Readiness
  - c. School Environment Readiness
  - d. Parent and Community Engagement Readiness
  - e. System Support Readiness
3. This tool shall be used before, during, and after the program implementation to support evidence-based planning, adaptive delivery, and continuous improvement.
4. All schools shall accomplish the SRRA through online forms provided by the Central Office, with data uploaded to the ARAL Dashboard, which serves as the official platform for monitoring readiness and tracking program implementation across all governance levels.
5. The following are the submission guidelines:
  - a. Initial SRRA Submission: on or before July 28, 2025
  - b. Beginning of School Year (BOSY) Update: on or before August 15, 2025
  - c. Mid-Year and Year-End Updating: Schools are encouraged to update their SRRA data during Mid-Year and Year-End reviews, as needed. A separate memorandum will be issued to guide schools for these updates.
