In support of evidence-based decision-making as well as the Five-point Reform Agenda and Quality Basic Education Development Plan (QBEDP) 2025-2035, the Policy and Planning Service-Policy Research and Development Division (PPS-PRDD) is presently studying school reporting practices of bullying cases/incidences. This study aims to respond to the Philippines being identified as a bullying hotspot in the PISA 2022 results and acknowledges the critical need for accurate and timely reporting of bullying incidents in schools.

In this regard, the PPS-PRDD will carry out simultaneous data collection activities to assess the current state of bullying-related behaviors and reporting mechanisms in schools. These include survey questionnaires, key informant interviews (KIIs), and focus group discussions (FGDs) in selected schools from the SDOs of Isabela (Region II), Parañaque City (National Capital Region), Quezon City (National Capital Region), Sarangani (Region XII), and Sorsogon (Region V). Randomly selected learners from the identified schools (see Annex 1) will serve as respondents for the survey. Meanwhile, teachers will serve as participants in the FGDs, and school heads will be interviewed through KIIs (see Annex 2).

In line with this, this office respectfully requests the assistance of the Regional Office-Policy, Planning and Research Division (PPRD) and SDO-Schools Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) to facilitate the conduct of data gathering activities of the study.

Particularly, RO-PPRD through the Regional Research Coordinators shall:





















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- a. Ensure the progress of data collection through FGD, KII, and survey administration in collaboration with the selected SDOs; and
- Coordinate with representatives from the PPS-PRDD for the itinerary and conduct of the data gathering activity (to be announced).

On the other hand, the SDO-SGOD through the SEPS for Planning and Research:

- a. Coordinate with the selected schools within their jurisdiction to identify the target survey respondents and participants;
- b. Collaborate with representatives from the PPS-PRDD for the itinerary and conduct of the FGDs (e.g., selecting venues, schedule of the activities);
- Assist targets schools in identifying FGD and KII participants in accordance with the specified criteria (see Annex 2); and,
- d. Assist the School Heads and School Personnel in distributing the invitation letters to the identified participants (to be provided).

For School Heads:

- a. Ensure that the selected participants have fully accomplished the Confirmation Slips attached to the invitation letters (to be provided);
- Identify the survey respondents, FGD and KII participants in accordance with the specified criteria; and
- c. Participate in the Key Informant Interviews

To ensure clear and efficient communication with the Regional and Schools Division Office focal persons, this office respectfully requests the Research Coordinators and SEPS for Planning and Research to attend an online orientation on Monday, 30 June 2025 via MS Teams https://tinyurl.com/OrientationBullying.

Data gathering activities shall adhere to the Data Privacy Act of 2012 and all data will be handled with the utmost confidentiality and used exclusively for the purposes of this data gathering activity.
