In reference to DepEd Order Nos. 76 and 86, s. 2012 entitled Guidelines on Revitalizing Boy Scouting in Schools Nationwide and Guidelines on Revitalizing Girl Scouting in Schools Nationwide, the South Cotabato Girl Scout Council will conduct its 33rd GSP Council Camp on **October 25-28, 2025** at *Kiamba National High School and Kiamba Central SPED Center, Kiamba, Sarangani Province*.

Participation that falls on weekends, attendees shall be granted **service credits or compensatory time-off**, whichever is applicable, pursuant to **DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003** (Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers) and **CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004** (Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services Rendered).
7. Travel and other expenses incurred by the participants during the activity shall be charged to local/ MOOE/GSP funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
