TRAINING OF TEACHERS ON TEACHING MAPEH

1. The Curriculum Implementation Division - Instruction Management Section (CID-IMS) will conduct a 2-day live-in Training of Teachers on Teaching MAPEH on November 26-27, 2025, at Sarangani Highlands Garden and Restaurant, General Santos City.
2. The training aims to:
 - a. Explain the current trends, standards, and competencies in the MAPEH curriculum under the revised K-12 Basic Education Curriculum.
 - b. Demonstrate varied teaching strategies that cater to diverse learning styles in the MAPEH classroom.
 - c. Develop contextualized and developmentally appropriate lesson plans, learning materials, and performance-based assessments for MAPEH.
 - d. Collaborate with fellow teachers in crafting innovative learning designs that promote holistic learner development.
3. Participants are advised to bring a laptop, portable wi-fi, and extension wire. Attached herewith are the list of participants and the activity matrix for easy reference.
4. The participation of the identified teachers in this undertaking is subject to the non-disruption-of-classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9 s. 2005, entitled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith. Concerned School Heads must ensure that all classes of the teacher-participants must be prorated and/or handled by the available teacher.
5. Food, venue, and accommodation shall be charged to Division office funds while transportation and other expenses of the participants shall be charged to any available funds, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. All program management team and resource speakers shall conduct a pre-work activity on November 25, 2025, at the DepEd Conference Room,
