2026 SARANGANI PROVINCIAL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION MEET

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Public Schools District Supervisors
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads Concerned

1. The Department of Education – Schools Division of Sarangani will conduct the Sarangani Provincial Athletic Association (SPAA) Meet from February 3-7, 2026, to be hosted by the Local Government Unit of Kiamba, Sarangani Province in collaboration with the Municipality of Maitum.
2. The objectives of the SPAA Meet are as follows:
 - a) To ensure the continuing sports spirit among the pupils/students, teachers, and school officials.
 - b) To showcase the stakeholders' strong desire to have sustainable programs for children at an early age, pursuing sports excellence, discipline, and values inherent in the practice of sports and physical education.
 - c) To widen the base for talent identification, selection, recruitment, training, and exposure of elementary and secondary learners.
 - d) To provide a database for a valid and universal basis to further improve the school sports development program.
 - e) To promote sportsmanship, camaraderie, and unity among competitors through friendly competition; and
 - f) To create an inclusive environment where students of varying abilities and backgrounds can participate, ensuring that sports activities cater to diverse interests and capabilities.
3. The learner-athletes must meet the following requirements to qualify for the sports meet:
 - a) Must be physically fit (undergone medical and dental examination);
 - b) Must be of Good Moral Character.
 - c) Those who were born on or after January 1, 2013 for the Elementary Level and January 1, 2008 for the Junior and Senior High School.
 - d) Must be recommended by their respective Delegation Heads; and
 - e) Must meet the guidelines set by the Division Selection and Accreditation Committee (DSAC)

4. Teacher-coaches shall prepare their lesson plans and activities intended for the day they are requested to attend. School heads/department heads shall ensure that a teacher will take over their subject loads to avoid disruption of classes.
5. All DepEd personnel involved in this activity shall be entitled to appropriate service credits and compensatory time off, whichever is applicable
6. Participating delegation should take charge of the subsistence (meals, snacks, and transportation) and uniforms of their members chargeable against local funds/SEF/MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Other allowable expenses shall be taken from the 2025/2026 SEF.
7. Tournament Managers and Officials are advised to be at their respective playing venues on February 2, 2026, for the necessary preparatory activities.
8. All qualified coaches are also required to attend the Refresher Training on January 26-30, 2026 at Kiamba National High School.
9. A solidarity Meeting for all tournament managers, officials, coaches, and delegation heads will be held on February 4, 2026, 9:00 am at Kiamba Central Elementary School SPED Center, to be followed by the parade of respective municipal delegations at 3:00 p.m.
10. Saludo during the parade will also be done and will be a competition. Mechanics is enclosed.

GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS FOR SALUDO

1. A total of one hundred (100) athletes may participate, regardless of whether they are from the elementary or high school level.
2. The duration of the performance shall be two (2) to three (3) minutes.
3. The use of props is strictly prohibited; however, accessories such as caps, gloves, or umbrellas may be used, if they are securely attached to the performers' uniforms and as part of the delegation uniform.
4. The selection of music shall be at the discretion of the choreographer, if it does not contain any foul, explicit, or inappropriate lyrics.

<i>Performance</i>	30%
<i>Choreography</i>	30%
<i>Total:</i>	100%
