Requirements	Description
Devices (Laptop, Tablet, Desktop, Computers)	<p>For Public elementary and Junior High Schools including IPED implementing schools and School serving IP learners, the schools must have one device for learners in a particular section who will utilize Khan Academy.</p> <p>Being a Khan Academy does <b>not</b> require all teachers or all sections to use it immediately. The school <b>may start with one section</b> and gradually expand to more sections in the following years.</p> <p>For ALS School-Based Learning Centers and Community Learning Centers, the School Head or</p>



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	EPSA must verify whether ALS learners have devices available at the center or as personal devices that can be used during Khan Academy sessions.
Internet Connection	For public Elementary and Junior High Schools, including IPED implementing schools and schools serving Indigenous Peoples (IP) learners, the school must have a stable internet connection with a minimum speed of 100 Mbps.  ALS learners who will use Khan Academy outside the school must have a stable internet connection.
