REITERATION ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE 2026 SUMMER  
REMEDATION PROGRAMS

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent  
Chief Education Supervisors  
Public Schools District Supervisors  
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads  
All Others Concerned

1. In reference to DepEd Order No. 010, s. 2026, entitled *Guidelines on the Implementation of the 2026 Summer Remediation Programs (ARAL Summer Programs and Summer Academic Remedial Program [SARP])*, this office reiterates the prescribed procedures, documentation requirements, and implementation timelines for schools intending to conduct the ARAL Summer Program for SY 2025–2026 scheduled from May 6 to June 2, 2026.

2. All concerned schools are hereby directed to observe the following provisions strictly:

- a. Intent to Implement the ARAL Summer Program
  - i. Prior to the submission of any documentary requirements, schools intending to conduct the ARAL Summer Program must confirm their intention by encoding the projected enrollment through the official link:

  - ii. Only schools with duly confirmed intent shall be considered for enrollment encoding, budget allocation, and the distribution of learning resources.
- b. Submission of Required Documentary Requirements
  - i. Upon confirmation of intent, schools are required to prepare and submit a *School Letter of Intent* to implement the ARAL Summer Program. The letter must be duly signed by the School Head and approved by the Schools Division Superintendent (SDS), accompanied by the following attachments:
    1. Class List indicating:
      - a. Name of Teacher/Tutor
      - b. Names of Learners
    2. Approved Class Program
    3. Teacher's Class Schedule
    4. Related Memorandum (Central Office or Division Office issuance)



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- ii. All documents shall be complete, accurate, and properly endorsed.
- c. Enrollment Encoding (Detailed Data)
  - i. After confirmation, schools shall encode the detailed enrollment data using the official enrollment system link:

- d. Deadline of encoding for the Provision of Teaching and Learning Resources
  - i. Encoding of complete enrollment data is until May 5, 2026, at exactly 12:00 noon.
  - ii. Important Reminder:
    - 1. *No encoded and complete enrollment data means no basis for resource allocation, including learning materials and other program resources.*
    - 2. *Late or incomplete submissions shall not be accommodated for the provision of resources*
- e. Teacher Participation and Documentation
  - i. *DepEd Teachers* who are willing to serve as ARAL or SARP teachers shall accomplish a *Letter of Intent*, following the official template provided in the referenced DepEd Memorandum.
  - ii. Teachers who opt not to render summer classes shall likewise submit a written letter to the School Head stating their decision, for monitoring purposes.
  - iii. School Heads shall consolidate and compile all teacher's intent letters of and non-participation letters as part of the school's official documentation.
- f. Learner Participation and Parental Consent
  - i. Schools shall secure a written parental consent for all learners who will participate in the ARAL Summer Program.
  - ii. Likewise, parents or guardians who do not allow their child to join the summer program shall provide written confirmation, to be kept on file.
  - iii. This documentation is required to ensure accountability, proper monitoring, and evaluation of program coverage.
- g. Non-DepEd ARAL Volunteers
  - i. *Non-DepEd Volunteers* shall be required to submit a Letter of Intent using the prescribed template provided in the DepEd Memorandum. Priority in the selection of volunteers shall be accorded to the applicants listed in the Registry of Qualified Applicants (RQA) and practice teachers. Additionally, fresh graduates, youth volunteers, and other qualified individuals may also be considered as alternative volunteer sources, subject to existing guidelines and specific needs of the school.
  - ii. Schools shall ensure that a Job Contract is accomplished for all Non-DepEd Volunteers, in accordance with the provisions of the reference memorandum.



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- iii. The School Head shall ensure that all terms, conditions, scope of work, and agreements with Non-DepEd Volunteers are clearly explained, documented, and properly acknowledged prior to the delivery of services.
  - iv. For detailed provisions on Non-DepEd Volunteers, schools are advised to refer to the relevant DepEd Memorandum cited in the reference documents.
