**LEARNING CONTINUITY IN EMERGENCIES**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent  
Education Program Supervisors  
Public Schools District Supervisors / Principal In-charge  
Principal / School Heads / Teacher-in-Charge  
All Elementary and Secondary Teachers  
Both Public and Private Schools

1. In light of frequent suspension of classes in the entire province due to the earthquake, the Division acknowledges the significant disruption this situation poses to our regular school activities. In response, and in accordance with DepEd Order No. 14, s. 2026 titled: "Guidelines on Learning Continuity in Emergencies", this office emphasizes that learning continuity must be upheld. Thus, the well-being of learners and personnel is fundamental to their capacity to learn and teach effectively.
2. Teachers are encouraged to maintain active communication with learners through online platforms, text messages, or other remote methods to provide guidance, address questions, and support distance or blended learning. Accurate records of student engagement and completed work tasks must be kept to monitor progress and identify learning gaps that require intervention.
3. School heads and teachers are expected to closely monitor learners' progress during distance and/or blended learning, ensuring timely feedback and guidance. They must also provide appropriate support to address challenges arising from the remote learning environment, thereby sustaining effective engagement and academic growth.
