1.  - e. Validate the Implementation of the LRMIS

 - e. List of locally provided LRs (delivered, expected delivery, and for procurement)
 - f. Composition of inspectorate team (RO, SDO, schools)
4. District Heads are requested to coordinate with the host schools on the schedule and accommodation of the monitoring team.
