**DIVISION MEMORANDUM**

**ACTIVATION OF THE DIVISION EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent-Designate  
Chiefs SGOD and CID  
All Public Schools District Supervisors Concerned  
All Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads Concerned  
All Others Concerned

1. In view of the recent earthquake affecting the Province of Sarangani on June 8, 2026, and pursuant to the directives of the Regional Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (RDRRMC) and the Department of Education Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS), this office is hereby directs the immediate deployment of Division DRRM Team and Division Engineers for Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) to ensure timely coordination, monitoring, reporting, and response operations.
2. The Division Emergency Operations Center of the Schools Division Office of Sarangani is hereby activated starting June 9, 2026, 8:00 AM and shall remain active until deactivation.
3. The activation aims to:
  - a. Monitor the effects of the hazard on schools, learners, teaching and non-teaching personnel;
  - b. Facilitate the collection, validation, consolidation, and submission of disaster-related reports;
  - c. Ensure continuous coordination with DepEd Regional Office XII, Local DRRM Councils, and other partner agencies;
  - d. Provide timely advisories, updates, and recommendations regarding education continuity and safety measures, and
  - e. Support emergency response, recovery, and rehabilitation interventions.
4. All School Heads are directed to:
  - a. Activate their respective School DRRM Teams;

- b. Conduct rapid assessment and submit initial and subsequent situational reports through prescribed reporting channels;
  - c. Monitor the safety and condition of learners, personnel, and school facilities;
  - d. Coordinate immediately with their respective District Supervisors and the Division DRRM Coordinator for urgent concerns; and
  - e. Ensure dissemination of official advisories and emergency preparedness measures to all stakeholders.
  - f. The Division DRRM Team shall maintain a 24/7 monitoring and reporting mechanism and ensure prompt submission of consolidated reports to higher offices as required.
