PROFILING OF SCHOOLS FOR EARLY RECOVERY AND REHABILITATION

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent-Designate
Chiefs SGOD and CID
All Public Schools District Supervisors Concerned
All Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads Concerned
All Others Concerned

1. In view of the recent earthquake that affected various schools within the Division of Sarangani, and in preparation for the safe and orderly resumption of classes, this Office hereby directs all School Heads to conduct and submit the Early Recovery and Rehabilitation Profiling Report of their respective schools.
2. The profiling aims to gather essential information on the status of schools during the early recovery and rehabilitation phase, including but not limited to:
 - a. School response to the Incident Reporting Management System (IRMS);
 - b. Status of teaching and non-teaching personnel;
 - c. Total number of enrolled learners;
 - d. Condition and usability of classrooms and other learning facilities;
 - e. Target date for the resumption of classes;
 - f. Learning modalities to be implemented during the transition period; and
 - g. Psychosocial support and other interventions provided to personnel and learners.
3. To facilitate efficient consolidation and analysis of data, all concerned School Heads shall submit their responses through the official Google Link available at: <https://bit.ly/4gyTjTs>.
4. Schools are enjoined to regularly update their responses should there be significant changes in their recovery and rehabilitation status.
5. The data gathered shall serve as the basis for planning, resource mobilization, prioritization of interventions, rehabilitation efforts, establishment of learning continuity spaces, clean-up and clearing

operations, and other necessary recovery measures to ensure the continuity of education services.

6. All School Heads are instructed to complete the attached Early Recovery and Rehabilitation Profiling Form accurately and in full. The accomplished report shall be submitted to the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) through the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) Coordinator **on or before June 24, 2026, 5:00 PM.**
7. District Supervisors are directed to monitor compliance and provide technical assistance to schools within their respective districts to ensure the timely submission and validation of data.
