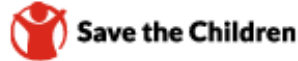

As part of the continuing implementation of **PADAYON SA DOS MIL BAYNTE-SAIS** and the transition to **Catch-Up Clubs (CuCs) Version 3.0**, Save the Children Philippines respectfully seeks your support for the conduct of **"Be-Hasa 2026: The CuCs 3.0 Facilitators Training Workshop"**, scheduled on **July 6–10, 2026**.

This five-day intensive capacity-building initiative is designed to equip volunteer Community Learning Facilitators (CLFs) and Community Learning and Inclusion Facilitators (CLIFs) with the fundamental knowledge, skills, and practical experience necessary to effectively deliver CuCs 3.0 in their respective learning sites. The title "Be-Hasa" is derived from the Filipino word *bihasa*, meaning highly skilled or well-trained, underscoring the objective of developing facilitators who are both knowledgeable and confident in practice.

Specifically, the training aims to:

- Strengthen understanding of the CuCs 3.0 framework, including objectives, structure, and implementation strategies;
- Deepen knowledge of inclusion and child protection principles, ensuring reasonable accommodations for learners with functional difficulties;
- Build competencies in CuCs assessment, learner progress monitoring, and climate-adaptive approaches for learning continuity;
- Provide immersive practice and planning sessions, culminating in a Demo Fest where participants simulate CuCs sessions, apply strategies, and receive feedback.

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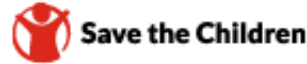
