SDO SARANGANI EDUCATION STAKEHOLDER CONVERGENCE

To: Asst. Schools Division Superintendent
Functional Division Chiefs
All Other Schools Division Office Personnel

1. In support of the implementation of the Adopt-a-School Program (ASP) pursuant to Republic Act No. 8525, and in line with the continuing efforts of the Schools Division Office of Sarangani to strengthen education partnerships and mobilize resources for learning recovery and school rehabilitation, the Schools Division Office of Sarangani, in partnership with the Conrado & Ladislawa Alcantara Foundation, Inc. (CLAFI), shall conduct the SDO Sarangani Education Stakeholder Convergence with the theme *“Restoring Learning, Rebuilding Schools, Strengthening Futures”* on **July 30, 2026**, at **9:00 a.m.** at **Sun City Suites, General Santos City**.
2. The activity shall serve as the official platform for stakeholder engagement and resource mobilization under Bangon SDO Sarangani. During the convergence, the Conrado & Ladislawa Alcantara Foundation, Inc. (CLAFI) shall formally launch the Tuloy-Aralan: Sarangani Learning Recovery and Rehabilitation Program (2026–2029) in partnership with the Schools Division Office of Sarangani to support the continuing recovery of the education sector in the province.
3. Specifically, the convergence aims to:
 - a. present the current education recovery and rehabilitation needs.
 - b. launch the Tuloy-Aralan Program and its priority interventions.
 - c. strengthen collaboration among government agencies, private sector partners, civil society organizations, and development partners.
 - d. explore opportunities for resource mobilization and classroom rehabilitation initiatives; and
 - e. promote stakeholder participation through the Adopt-a-School Program pursuant to Republic Act No. 8525.
4. Invited participants shall include education stakeholders, partner organizations, representatives from government and private institutions, school heads, district supervisors, and selected Division personnel.
5. All concerned personnel are directed to provide the necessary support and coordination to ensure the successful conduct of the activity.
