**CONDUCT OF THE OPERATIONAL SAFE (OpSafe) ROLL-OUT IN IDENTIFIED EARTHQUAKE
AFFECTED ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Public School District Supervisors
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. In support of the psychosocial recovery of learners affected by the recent earthquake in Sarangani Province and pursuant to the invitation of the Philippine Children's Ministries Network (PCMN), in partnership with Food for the Hungry Philippines (FHI), this office announces the conduct of the Operation Safe (OpSafe) Roll-Out in the identified elementary schools from August 3-7, 2026.
2. The OpSafe Roll-out is a child-focused psychosocial support intervention designed to provide learners with a safe and supportive environment through structured play, storytelling, songs, games, and other facilitated activities that promote emotional healing, resilience, and hope following the recent disaster.
3. The activity shall be implemented in the identified schools in coordination with the Philippines Children's Ministries Network (PCMN), trained facilitators, and school personnel. The detailed schedule, venue, and other implementation arrangements are provided in the Operation Safe Roll-Out List of trained facilitators with schools assigned, invitation letter, and Matrix attached as Enclosures 1 and 2 of this Memorandum.
4. School Heads of the identified schools are hereby requested to:
 - a. Coordinate with the Opsafe facilitators to ensure the smooth implementation of the activity.
 - b. Identify and ensure the attendance of the target learners.



c. Prepare the venue and provide the necessary logistical and

administrative support during the conduct of the roll-out; and

d. Extend full assistance to the facilitator and partner organizations to ensure the successful implementation of the program.

5. Expenses incidental to the participation of DepEd personnel shall be subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations, while expenses of the partner organization shall be charged against their respective funds.

Dear Ma'am Estacio,

Philippine Children's Ministries Network is a national faith-based non-profit organization, licensed and accredited with DSWD, organized since 1998. We work in Sarangani through our member agencies and partners Share an Opportunity and Mindanao Children's Ministries Network, and as supported by Food for the Hungry Philippines.

We have extensive experience in responding to psychological first aid to children with our program called **Operation Safe**. This program has been used in the 2025 Mindanao Earthquake in Manay, Davao Occidental, typhoons in various parts of the country and after the aftermath of the Marawi Siege.

We conduct Operation Safe to mitigate the psychological and emotional impact of the 7.8 earthquake in Sarangani. Through structured play, storytelling and group activities, Operation Safe helps children regain sense of normalcy and security. It empowers children to express their emotions and develop healthy coping mechanism in a safe space guided by caring adults and facilitators.

As part of localization of the response, and to strengthen child protection mechanism, we engage locals in the conduct of the children's camps. The program calls for training of trainers and facilitators who will in turn roll out the program in their respective agencies and or field assignment.

In this connection, we invite **five (5) representatives from each school namely: Calpidong ES, San Vicente ES, Kiogam Central ES, and Ilaya ES** to attend the **Live-Out Facilitators' Training on Operation Safe Program** preferably from host schools which will be held on July 20-22, 2026 tentatively at Brgy. Ilaya Gym. The participants must be willing to fully attend the three day training with our consultant from Japan, Jonathan Wilson, PhD with Filipino trainers and conduct the said roll out on an agreed schedules. PCMN will take charge of meals on days of training (2 snacks and lunch/day), but participants should take care of its own accommodations and transportation to and from venue.

As we together respond to the varied needs of children and families in the quake affected areas, we will be glad to work with your representatives to this event.
