**SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM (SBFP) MONITORING IN ALL  
ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS OF THE SCHOOLS DIVISION OF SARANGANI**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

1. In line with the implementation of the Department of Education's School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) and to ensure compliance with program standards and guidelines, the Schools Division Office of Sarangani, through the School Governance Operation Division (SGDO)-School Health and Nutrition Section (SHNS), shall conduct monitoring activities in all public elementary schools
2. The monitoring shall be conducted anytime during the pre-implementation, ongoing implementation and post -implementation phases of the School-Based Feeding Program for School Year 2026-2027
3. Monitoring aims to:
  - a. Assess the preparedness of schools prior to the implementation of the feeding program.
  - b. Monitor the proper implementation of SBFP activities, including food preparation, Food safety and sanitation, feeding procedures and program documentation.
  - c. Validate the utilization of program resources and compliance with DepEd policies and guidelines.
  - d. Provide technical assistance and recommendations to improve program implementation.





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4. The School- Based Feeding Program (SBFP) Monitoring Team shall be composed of personnel from the School Health and Nutrition Section and Division Top Management and other authorized personnel.
5. School Heads, District Nurses, District Consolidators, School SBFP Coordinators and other concerned personnel are directed to make all necessary records and documents available during the monitoring and ensure full cooperation with the Monitoring Team.
6. Meals and traveling expenses of the Monitoring Team shall be charged against Local funds or SBFP funds if available, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
